



## CCAP03 – Agile Project Management (AgilePM®) Foundation

### Description

This course prepares candidates for the AgilePM Foundation Certificate. AgilePM® provides an approach that offers agility but retains the concept of a project, project delivery and project management. It works alongside more formal approaches such as PRINCE2® and complements quality processes such as ISO90001 and CMMI.

Agile Project Management is based on DSDM Consortium's Atern method, which is the oldest established Agile approach that delivers the right solution at the right time.

By obtaining the AgilePM® Foundation Certificate, you will have demonstrated an understanding of Agile Project Management philosophy, principles, processes, people, products, techniques and guidance applied within a project.

The AgilePM® Foundation examination aims to measure whether the learner can act as an informed member of a project team using AgilePM®.

### Learning Objectives

Successful candidates will receive an internationally recognized AgilePM® Foundation certificate, which is administered by the APM Group.

### Course Duration

The pre-course work is recommended in order for the learner to obtain full benefit of the time spent with the trainer in the classroom. The pre-course work will be given to you at the Orientation Session & upon receipt of will take approximately 10 hours of self study time.

This is a 3 day module which starts at 08:00 and finishes at 17:00.

Learners must be aware that there is evening work required on Day 1 and Day 2 of the course. Learners will write a Foundation examination which takes place in the form of 60 multiple-choice questions during the afternoon of the last day of the course. You need to achieve a minimum of 30 correct answers out of 60 questions in order to pass the examination.
