



## CCAP04 – Agile Project Management (AgilePM®) Practitioner

### Description

This course prepares candidates for the AgilePM Practitioner Certificate. AgilePM® provides an approach that offers agility but retains the concept of a project, project delivery and project management. It works alongside more formal approaches such as PRINCE2® and complements quality processes such as ISO9001 and CMMI.

Agile Project Management is based on DSDM Consortium's Atern method, which is the oldest established Agile approach that delivers the right solution at the right time.

By obtaining the AgilePM® Practitioner Certificate, you will have demonstrated your ability to apply the concepts of Agile Project Management to the running and managing of projects through an Objective Test - a style of complex multiple choice examination - lasting two hours.

Successful candidates will receive an internationally recognized AgilePM® Practitioner certificate, which is administered by the APM Group.

You need to achieve a minimum of 30 correct answers out of 60 questions in order to pass the examination.
