Course Duration

Orientation Session, plus 10 hours of pre-work, plus 2 days Virtual classroom training.

Learning Time

Learners will write a Practitioner examination in the form of complex multiple-choice four questions per paper, with a maximum of 20 marks per question (80 question items) during the afternoon of the last day of the course. You need to achieve a minimum of 40 correct answers out of 80 question items in order to pass the examination. (2,5 hours, open book)
