Course Duration

Orientation Session, plus 10 hours of pre-work, plus 3 days Virtual classroom training.

Learning Time

Learners will write a Foundation examination which takes place in the form of 50 multiple choice questions during the afternoon of the last day of the course. You need to achieve a minimum of 25 correct answers out of 50 questions in order to pass the examination. (40 minutes, closed book)
